



Jerusalem Orphans

Back in 2011, Jeffrey Samuels, Trustee provoked discussion about our charity tithing. After being taken off the agenda and being put back on because of suggestions from external supports, including Pastor Doreen Teh, Emmanuel North West Church, God laid on the heart of Tope in 2012 after being inspired by Romans 15:27 to sow 10% of The Precious Foundation's annual income to Jerusalem orphans. With the Trustees' agreement, TPF donated £507 in September 2013, to aid Jerusalem orphans via a messianic ministry called Joseph Storehouse. These funds will be used specifically in the area of education, which meets one of The Precious Foundation's main objectives. Many of these orphans are from high risks backgrounds and put into special homes or shelters within a kibbutz, where they can be properly cared for along with other children. Each home has about 7-10 children and the parents act as role models. If it were not for charities like Joseph Storehouse, not only these orphans but the entire new family would suffer because the parent's resources would otherwise be insufficient. Tope travelled to Israel on a mission trip in June 2013, where her eyes were opened to many things both in the natural as well as the spiritual. There is still much poverty in Israel and from the conversation Tope had with a couple of Israeli women, they themselves confirmed the top 3 prayer requests were for peace, health and money.



TPF also gave financial support to the Biet Sar Shalom fellowship based in Jerusalem to aid their outreach to the youth who reside in a government run boarding school because they have been forced away from their parents. It seems that at least one of their parents is allowed to have contact with them at periodic times of the year. These funds will contribute to the teenager's toiletries and part of their history education.

We believe these opportunities are part of the divine plan of God, and we are thankful we can play our part in supporting these important ministries receiving blessings through our act of giving.

Na'ima legs are now in plaster so the healing process can be easily monitored. Na'ima is having regular checkups with the team who operated on her, and is currently back at The Abuja Children's Home recuperating.
